Contradictions Cheat Sheet

NON-ANTAGONISTIC Contradictions

- Contradiction between parties who share **common interests**
- Resolving these contradictions does not in and of itself change a fundamental contradiction
- **Example:** Workers Disagree with Collective Economic Rights at their Common Enemy (e.g. workers who do not support Fight for \$15 Campaign)

ANTAGONISTIC Contradictions

- Contradiction between parties who have **opposing interests**
- Can only be resolved one side winning at the expense of the other
- **Example:** Capitalists Exploit Workers, but we know that there is no such thing as a struggle where all workers struggle against all capitalists. In other words, there is no struggle of Pure Worker vs. Pure Capitalist in the real world.

FUNDAMENTAL Contradictions

- ▷ Main Antagonistic Contradictions of the system **as they exist in the abstract**

- ▷ Capitalists Exploit Workers, but we know that there is no such thing as a struggle between all workers and all capitalists. In other words, there is no struggle of Pure Worker vs. Pure Capitalist in the real world.

PRIMARY Contradictions

- ▷ Antagonistic Contradictions that **exist as the concrete manifestations of the fundamental contradictions in our material world**

- ▷ These contradictions are identified based on our analysis / assessment of the current conditions.

- ▷ These contradictions are consistently shifting / changing to the extent that conditions shift/ change as we struggle to isolate and defeat our enemies.
